

**HIKE No. 2802 - Maquoketa Caves State Park - Maquoketa, IA**  
**Saturday, November 18, 2023 – 2:30 PM**

Maquoketa Caves has six miles of trails that wind throughout the park and bring you to cave entrances and passages known for their crawling capability and unique flowstone and dripstone formations. The caves were formed after millennia of water erosion on limestone bedrock. This park contains more caves than any other state park in Iowa. We will determine which trails to hike depending upon weather on Hike Day. Come join us!

Directions: Maquoketa Caves State Park - 9688 Caves Rd, Maquoketa, IA. The Park is about 48 miles from Davenport. Follow HWY 61 North from Davenport. Just North of Maquoketa, take a left at County Road Y31 (Caves Road STATE HWY 428). Drive approx 5.5 miles and take a left at 98th St. Continue on this road for about .3 miles and arrive at the parks trail head where parking is available. Watch for HIKE signs. Restrooms are NOT available. Bring your own water and snacks.
