HIKE No. 2816 – Bellevue State Park - Bellevue, IA Saturday, March 9, 2024 – 2:30 PM

Today we will hike the trails of Bellevue State Park, located in Bellevue, Iowa. We will enjoy the scenic overlook of the town and Mississippi River, a portion of restored prairie, the remnant of an old limestone quarry, and the walking bridge connecting the town with the park.

Directions: From Davenport and I80, take IA Hwy 61 north approximately 42 miles to County E17. Turn right and travel about 4 mi. to its junction with IA Hwy 62. Turn left and travel north for about 12 miles to IA Hwy 52 (and the Mississippi River). Turn right onto IA Hwy 52 and travel about 2 mi. to the park entrance, which is right after crossing the bridge. We will meet at the large open shelter on the left at the top of the long hill. Watch for the HIKE signs. Bring your own water & snack.
