HIKE No. 2818 – Black Hawk State Historic Site - Rock Island, IL (A Dog Hike) Saturday, March 23, 2024 – 2:30 PM

Black Hawk State Historic Site is a 208-acre park with 6 miles of easy to moderate hiking trails located at 1510 46th Avenue, Rock Island, IL.

Directions from Iowa: From Centennial Bridge, follow Hwy 67 South (11th Street) through Rock Island. Turn left at 46th Avenue (IL Rte. 5). Turn left at the Singing Bird Center entrance and park in the lower parking lot. Watch for HIKE signs.

Directions from Illinois: From the junction of I-74 and John Deere Road/IL-5 West, drive 2.1 miles and then take the IL-5 ramp towards Rock Island. Continue on IL-5/Black Hawk Road for about 2.5 miles. After going under the pedestrian bridge, turn right at the Singing Bird Center entrance and park in the lower parking lot. Watch for HIKE signs.

This is a dog friendly park; hikers are welcome to bring a dog to this hike. Owners are responsible for providing proof of current vaccinations, signing a waiver, keeping the dog on a leash, and cleaning up after their dog while in the park. These guidelines are set up for the safety of the dog and others on the hike. Only the dogs that abide by these set guidelines will be allowed to participate with the BHHC hikers. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping this a successful dog hike.
