## HIKE No. 2825 – Spring Overnight – Lake Keomah State Park - Oskaloosa, IA Saturday and Sunday, June 1-2, 2024 - Hike at 2:30 PM

We will be camping at Lake Keomah State Park near Oskaloosa, Iowa, at a large group campsite. There is a dining lodge which has a dining room, kitchen, toilets and showers. There are two electric posts behind the lodge, one for camper plug-ins and one for the electric cord plug-ins for those who need them. The camping fee for all units is \$11 per night payable on arrival. The cost of 3 meals (Sat. night and 2 on Sunday) is \$15. Send meal cost to Vicki Kohl, 2212 W. 14<sup>th</sup> St., Davenport, IA 52804 by May 15th. The cost of the lodge will be shared and determined by the number of participants and collected at the overnight.

Directions: Go west on I-80. Take the "What Cheer" exit 201 and turn left onto IA Hwy 21. Drive south about 25 mi. to IA Hwy 92. Turn right (west) onto IA Hwy 92 and drive about 11 mi. to Queens Ave. There is a brown sign for Lake Keomah. Turn left (south) and go about 0.7 mi. to the park entrance on the left. Watch for HIKE signs in the park. Total mileage is about 133 mi. Oskaloosa is 5 mi. west of the park. Please bring your own water and snacks.
