Stay on Hwy. 1, turning right in Washington, then right on Hwy. 1 in Brighton. Follow signs to Lake Darling. It is about 115 mi. from the I-80 Bridge. If coming just for Saturday hike, watch for HIKE signs & bring water & snacks.
