

HIKE No. 2837 – Scott County Park - Park View, IA (Dog Hike)
Saturday, October 26, 2024 - 2:30 PM

This park has 1,280 acres and is the largest park in Scott County. Join us as we hike in whispering white pines and evergreen woods following well-marked trails. There are some small slopes with this hike that all ages and all levels can enjoy. This is a dog friendly park; hikers are welcome to bring a dog to this hike. Owners are responsible for providing proof of current vaccinations, signing a waiver, keeping the dog on a leash, and cleaning up after their dog while in the park. These guidelines are set-up for the safety of the dog and others on the hike. Only the dog owners that abide by these set guidelines will be allowed to participate with the BHHC hikers. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping this a successful dog hike. Directions: Take US 61 N. and exit at Long Grove exit. Turn right and travel to the next stop sign intersection. Turn left at the 4-way stop. Turn right at 270th St. and drive about 1½ mi. and turn left into the park. Inside the park, take the first right turn and drive for about a mile and park at the Indian Hills shelter. Watch for HIKE signs. Please bring your own water and snack.
